Taiwanese American Community Scholarship Award

Applicants should be US citizens (or permanent residents) and college-bound seniors in the graduating class of 2011 from high schools in Orange County, CA.

Please submit the application in the mail with the following documents:

1. A biography of no more than 500 words demonstrating leadership potential and commitment to public service. It must be typed, double-spaced, with size 12 font and one-inch margins on all four sides.
2. An essay of no more than 1000 words, on the topic below:
Indicate a person who has had a significant influence on you and describe that influence. It must be typed, double-spaced, with size 12 font and one-inch margins on all four sides.
3. One recommendation letter from one of your school teachers or counselors
4. A copy of your official high school transcript

Deadline: Your completed application must be postmarked no later than **April 4, 2011** and mailed to:

- A brief biography of no more than 250 words, to be used to introduce you at the award ceremony.
- A photo of yourself in JPEG no larger than 2 inches by 2 inches, to be included in the award ceremony program.

Award: A scholarship of \$500.00 and a plaque for each award recipient.

The applicants will be informed of the results by **May 2, 2011**.

Award Ceremony:

The award ceremony will be held from 3:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. on June 5, Sunday, 2011 at Irvine City Hall.

- (1) to promote community involvement and social service,
